

MEDIATION AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made this 21st day of September, 1978, by and between the participating carriers listed in Exhibit A attached hereto and hereby made a part hereof, and represented by the National Carriers' Conference Committee, and the employees shown thereon and represented by the Railroad Yardmasters of America, witnesseth:

IT IS HEREBY AGREED:

ARTICLE I - SCOPE AND EMPLOYEES AFFECTED

Existing scope rules shall be amended by the addition of the following:

The duties and responsibilities of a yardmaster include:

(a) Supervision over employees directly engaged in the switching, blocking, classifying and handling of cars and trains and duties directly incidental thereto that are required of the yardmaster in a territory as designated by the carrier.

(b) Such other duties as assigned by the carrier.

ARTICLE II - GENERAL PROVISIONS

A - Court Approval

This Agreement is subject to approval of the courts with respect to participating carriers in the hands of receivers or trustees.

B - Effect of this Agreement

This Agreement is in settlement of the pending scope rule notices served upon the carriers listed in Exhibit A by the Railroad Yardmasters of America. It shall be construed as a separate agreement by and on behalf of each of said carriers and their employees represented by the organization signatory hereto, and shall remain in effect until changed or modified in accordance with the provisions of the Railway Labor Act, as amended, provided, however, the parties to this Agreement shall not serve nor progress prior to January 1, 1981, not to become effective before April 1, 1981 any notices or proposals related to the subject matter of the notices settled by this Agreement.

The effective date of this Agreement shall be October 15, 1978.
